The girl walks over to the other children and hands one of the boys the peg she found on the ground. "*Watch me get it*" one boy said. As he tries to reach it with the peg, the girl says "*Can we reach it? Here let me try*". They both continue trying to get the leaf down.

One boy says, "*Let's get a box*". He pushes the pram out of the way and begins tipping the box over so he can reach inside to remove the smaller boxes.
